3. Memory activities:
 - a. Talk about what the verse means
 - Ask if there is a word they don't understand
 - Have them explain the verse in their own words
 - b. Draw pictures that represent key words or concepts
 - c. Act it out together or use hand motions
 - You can lookup keyword in American Sign Language on a website or app like [Handspeak.com](https://www.handspeak.com)
 - d. Write out the verse longhand on paper or a whiteboard
 - Erase a couple words and re-read it, remembering what goes in the blanks. Repeat this until the whole verse is memorized.
 - e. Write out phrases on index cards
 - Memorize them one at a time
 - Mix them up and try to put them back in order
